

Shattering the myths Many believe that women choose prostitution because they see it as an easy way to make money.

The reality is...

- upwards of 85% are victims of childhood sexual molestation and incest
- · most prostitutes are/were runaway or "throwaway" youth
- all of the women screened for the Mary Magdalene Project are victims of child abuse or neglect, No exceptions!
- prostitutes risk violence with every trick and are 9 times more likely to be murdered than the average woman
- the prostitute-trick relationship is based on power, degradation and violence
- · prostitutes working for a pimp give him all their income
- · prostitutes are victims acting out of no perceived options
- daughters of prostitutes are 6 times more likely to become prostitutes themselves
